

HONORS PROGRAM

Senior Honors Project Requirements and Application Process

- 1. Have two completed survey courses before the end of your junior year.
 - LACS 1 Introduction to Latin America and the Caribbean
 - LACS 4 History, Culture and Society: The Many Faces of Latin America
 - LATS 3 Introduction to Latino Studies
 - LATS 5 Complexities of Latino Identity
- Meet the minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.3 for all Dartmouth courses and 3.3 in the LALACS Major.
- 2. Obtain a faculty advisor.
- 3. Write a project proposal, have it signed by your faculty advisor, and submit it to the LALACS Dept. Administrator by May 15 of the junior year.
- By week 9 of fall term of the junior year, submit a five- to seven-page project prospectus to the LALACS Dept. Administrator to be reviewed and approved by the LALACS Dept. Steering Committee.
- 5. Enroll in LACS 98 in the fall of your senior year, and LACS 99 in the winter. If necessary, LACS 99 may continue in the spring term. In this case, a grade of ON (ongoing) will be assigned for LACS 99 for the winter term, and the final grade will be assigned at the end of the spring term.
- Honors Projects must be completed by the eighth week of spring term of the senior year.
 Students missing this deadline may be liable to lose eligibility for honors.
